



SCHOLARSHIP TERMS & CONDITIONS

The 2026 Saco Valley Credit Union (SVCU) Scholarship program will run from 3/18/2026 until 5/1/2026 at 5pm EST. Any submissions received after 5pm on May 1, 2026 will not be eligible for an award. Members must submit application via website at <https://sacovalley.org/about/scholarships/>.

Eligibility:

The Saco Valley Credit Union Scholarship program is open to high school seniors and non-traditional students that will be attending a college, university or post-graduate technical school in the Fall 2026 semester. Applicants must also be a member of Saco Valley Credit Union both at time of application and at time of award. Being a member means primary member. Saco Valley Credit Union employees are not eligible. Limit of 1 entry per applicant per year.

Applicant must complete a written essay. Essays must answer one of the following prompts:

Tell us about a time when you did or didn't do something that in turn, taught you an important life lesson about banking or finances, and explain how it impacted your life.

Tell us about a time when you volunteered and explain how that activity impacted your life and someone else's.

Format:

The prompts must be answered in written essay format, between 400 and 600 words, and include photographs to substantiate the impact. Photographs can be submitted via email to marketing@sacovalley.org.

Awards:

2 scholarships may be awarded in 2026 in the amount of \$2,500 each.

Each scholarship is a one-time award and will be sent to the school to be applied to any balances between July 1, 2026 and December 31, 2026. Upon notification of winning, the winner must reply to the email to confirm receipt and provide payment details for the school. SVCU will attempt 3 times to contact the winners between June 1, 2026 and June 30, 2026 – first 2 attempts by email and third attempt by phone. If there is no response after 48 hours of the third attempt via phone, the student will forfeit the scholarship.

Judging Criteria:

Applications will be reviewed for completion and eligibility. Eligible applicants' essays will be assigned scores by the scholarship committee based on both content and impact. The top 2 scored essays will receive the awards.
